Two-day computer-based exam. 420 multiple-choice questions, clinical decision-making cases, novel test item formats, including 22+ clinical cases

### **LEVEL 2-PE**

One-day 12-station standardized patient performance evaluation of fundamental osteopathic clinical skills




# FIRST TIME TAKER PASS RATE


## FIRST TIME TAKER PASS RATE


# FIRST TIME TAKER PASS RATE



## AGILITY IN DELIVERING SAFE TESTING

#### WEEKLY MONITORING OF TESTING CAPACITY

- Increased testing dates (incl. Saturdays and Sundays) and longer testing hours at many Prometric centers
- Procured "seat holds" for COMLEX-USA candidates from Prometric
- Weekly reports directly to contact at COMs informing them of their COM statistics (96% satisfaction rating from participating COMs)
- Expanded our CS team to increase available representatives and provide person-to-person contact to assist test takers

#### SATELLITE TESTING CENTER PARTNERSHIPS for CBT examinations July-September 2020

- Reduced urgent needs for testing seats
- UNTHSC-TCOM and MSU-COM

#### RESULTS OF EFFORTS

- Over 28,500 administrations completed by March 22, 2021 (since reopening of Prometric sites on 5/4/20)
  - Over 96% of the Class of 2022 took Level 1
  - Over 98% of the Class of 2021 took Level 2 CE
  - Over 12,000 Level 3 administrations

### **TEMPORARY ELIGIBILITY PATHWAYS FOR COMLEX-USA LEVEL 3**

PATHWAY 1: Classes of 2020 and 2021

(Passed COMLEX-USA Level 2-PE)

- Passing of both COMLEX-USA Level 2-CE and Level 2-PE
- Graduation from an accredited COM with DO degree
- Attestation of Program Director that you are in good academic and professional standing
- Recommended 6 months of GME completion

PATHWAY 2: Class of 2021 (Never Took COMLEX-USA Level 2-PE)

- Attestation by COM Dean that you have graduated and <u>have demonstrated</u> the fundamental osteopathic clinical skills necessary for graduation
- Attestation of Program Director that you are in good academic and professional standing
- Recommended 6 months of GME completion

PATHWAY 3: Classes of 2020 and 2021

(Unsuccessful Attempt of COMLEX-USA Level 2-PE)

- Attestation by COM Dean that you have graduated and <u>have demonstrated</u> the fundamental osteopathic clinical skills necessary for graduation
- Attestation of Program Director that you are in good academic and professional standing
- Required 6 months of GME completion





# NBOME UPDATE CAUTION

NBOME cautions residency program directors to avoid the sole use of any examination score, or the overuse or sole use of any examination program, in screening or hiring residents, and supports holistic admissions reviews


