Application platform:

ERAS

Application deadline:

 Strongly recommend having complete application on date of application release to programs

Match platform:

NRMP

Letters of recommendation:

 Recommend 3 or 4, most applicants have most or all letters from Faculty in Otolaryngology

Away rotation expectations:

- No requirement, data shows a high rate of receiving an interview offer when applicants complete an away rotation
- Many applicants complete one or two away rotations

Supplemental information:

• None.

Signal information:

• 25 signals, per AAMC guidelines applicants are expected to signal home and away rotation programs (unless applicants wish to prioritize other programs).

Use of USMLE/COMLEX scores:

- Applicants should have passed USMLE step 1 (Or COMLEX Equivalent)
- Recommended that applicants have USMLE step 2 score at time of application release to programs

Interview invitation process:

• Otolaryngology uses a universal interview release date- Generally a Thursday or Friday in early November with a delay in scheduling until the following Monday.

Interview format:

• Programs choose interview format – anticipate majority of programs will complete in-person interviews

Applicant communications:

• No recommendations

Second Look/Open House planning:

• No Specialty-specific guidance – anticipate few experiences with most programs completing in-person interviews
