Osteopathic Applicants

Advantages

- Increased training in hands on manipulation and physical exam skills
- Diversity of experience and perspective
- Holistic approach to patient care
- Grit and determination (seeking out experiences and mentorship)

Challenges

- Unclear level of clinical exposure and experience
- Lack of exposure to certain specialties and associated mentorship, research, and LORs
- Trouble interpreting COMLEX scores and other forms of evaluation

IMG Applicants

Advantages

- Prior clinical experience (practicing in another country)
- Diverse life experience and possibility maturity
- Unique perspective
- Often very motivated

Challenges

- Variable quality of clinical education
- Difficulty in assessing performance and evaluations in medical school
- Language and cultural barriers possibly leading to communication issues
- Possible gaps in clinical practice
